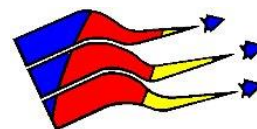


Archery ACT Grants to Club members



Members of Canberra Archery Club, Tuggeranong Archery Club and Weston Valley Archery Club may apply to Archery ACT for a grant to assist them in their participation, as a Team Member, in International Archery Events (World Championships, World Cups, Trans-Tasman, INVICTUS Games, etc.).

Grant Conditions

To be eligible to receive a grant the applicant must:

- be an active AACT club member for a minimum period of 24 months prior to the event;
- have been selected by Archery Australia (or equivalent) to represent the country in an international event; and
- apply to the AACT Secretary, in writing, for a grant prior to the nominated event. The application must include proof of being selected to represent Australia.

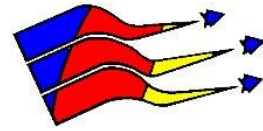
Grants to a maximum of \$1000 per person per financial year are available to AACT members (subject to AACT Budget). Helpers of para-archers are also eligible for a grant.

Successful applicants must provide the Society with an acquittal report on their participation in the event, within two months of their return to Australia. The report is to include their performance, photos of their participation in the event for publication on the AACT's website and any other relevant information.

In deciding whether to award a grant, AACT will consider the above eligibility requirements including whether the applicant has acquitted any previous grants.
