

TEAM SELECTION POLICY

Archery ACT Society Inc

November 2023

This policy outlines the expectations and selection process for AACT Teams

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1. Overview

Archery Australia (AA) typically holds four National Championships each year, for which each recognised governing body (RGB) can nominate a representative team. The four events are: National Target Championships (Open Nationals), Youth National Championships (Youth Nationals), National Field/Australian Open Field Championships and National Indoor Championships. Each of these tournaments is composed of team and individual competitions. This policy outlines the processes and procedures available for all archers intending to be a member of the ACT Team competing at any Archery Australia National Championships.

2. Team Composition

Archery ACT (AACT) Teams will be selected in line with current AA rules and/or policies, from among archers who apply and are eligible to compete at the National Archery Championships. A summary of the team composition for each event is provided below, which is current as of 2023.

Open Nationals:

- a recurve team comprised of a maximum four (4) men and four (4) women; and
- a compound team comprised of a maximum four (4) men and four (4) women; competing in any class.

Youth Nationals:

Teams will compete in the 720 and 900 rounds, Indoor and Marked Field.

- Teams can comprise archers from any division: U14 through to U21
- o There will be an RGB Recurve Team and an RGB Compound Team
- Teams will comprise a maximum of eight (8) archers.
- o Teams will be of mixed gender with female representation of the team being as follows:
 - A team of eight must include 3 females
 - A team of seven archers must include 2 females
 - A team of six must include 2 females
 - A team of five must include 2 females
 - A team of four must include 1 female

Indoor Nationals:

A Senior Recurve team, a Senior Compound team, a Senior Barebow Recurve team, a Youth Recurve team, and a Youth Compound team

The composition of each team shall be up to four (4) athletes, with the composition of each team as follows:

- Teams will be of mixed gender:
 - A team of four must include no more than 75% of one gender
 - A team of three must include no more than 66% of one gender
 - A team of two must include no more than 50% of one gender.
 - Each youth team can include only 1xU14, 1xU16, 1xU18, and 1xU21

3. Team Member Expectations

Once selected, team members must:

- Be and remain financial members of an AACT affiliated archery club while on the team;
- Compete in all events that make up the team competition at the given tournament for which they are selected;
- Shoot the bow type for which they were selected;
- Provide evidence of registration in the event;
- Comply with all current tournament and shooting rules and team guidelines;
- Adhere to the Athletes Code of Conduct;
- Wear the AACT uniform at the event:
- Comply with team management directives at the event;
- Attend sanctioned team events in the lead up to the National event;
- Participate in AACT team activities unless excused;
- Sign a Media Consent Form (Appendix 4) for the promotion of AACT; and
- Support the objectives of AACT.

Selected Team members are encouraged to:

- Attend the event dinner, and;
- Attend the AACT annual dinner for the year of the event.

4. Team Selection

- The selection period will commence after the previous championships or 10 months prior to the relevant Championships, whichever is greater.
- The closing date for applications will be announced by AACT in the given year.
- Archers will be required to submit two (2) verified scores for each event that form part of the team competition at the relevant National Championships. Minimum scores for selection are provided in Appendix 1.
- Scores must be shot during the selection period at a club, state, or nationally registered event with score sheets or Archers Diary to be added as a reference.
- Archers seeking team selection must complete an application form (AACT Team Application Form –
 Appendix 2) and submit it to the AACT secretary by the nominated closing date.
- Archers who do not attain scores as outlined in Appendix 1 are still encouraged to submit an application form, as they may be considered by the AACT Committee for inclusion in the team.

5. Team Captains

- AACT invites archers to express their interest in the position of team captain by submitting an expression of interest as indicated in their team application. (Appendix 2)
- The team captain will support their team and all AACT archers competing at the event.

6. Uniforms

- The AACT team shooting uniform shall be worn at all times by team members in competition during the Indoor, Youth and/or Open National Championships. Breaches of this directive may result in sanctions, including loss of any financial reimbursements.
- Uniform consists of AACT approved shirt with name on the back, and black shorts/skirt/trousers.
- Team members will be supplied two (2) shirts free of charge by AACT Society Inc. Additional shirts will be the responsibility of the archer.
- Provided there are no changes to the team shirt, team members who already possess a team shirt can request a monetary amount, equivalent to the two shirts, to go towards their registration in the event.
- Archers competing at the national events who are not part of the team may elect to purchase a
 generic AACT shirt at their own expense.

7. Parents/Carers

- Where a team member is under 18 years of age their parent(s)/guardian(s) shall acknowledge in the member's written application, that the Team Member's behaviour, participation and matters relating to shooting shall be vested in the Team Manager and Assistant Manager.
- An ACT team application form (Appendix 2) and media consent form (Appendix 4) shall be completed and signed by parent(s)/guardian(s) and archers and submitted to the AACT Secretary prior to the closing date for applications.
- All AACT team members under 18 years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian, with contact details and information provided to the team manager and AACT Secretary prior to the Championships.
- Accompanying parent(s)/guardian(s) are encouraged to sign a media consent form for themselves (Appendix 4) and provide it to the team manager and AACT Secretary prior to the Championships.

8. AACT Team Officials

- People interested in being AACT team managers, assistant managers or team coach must express an
 interest by nominating with the relevant form (Appendix 3), submitted by the closing date for Team
 Member applications as specified by AACT.
- AACT Team Officials will be given the cost of entry to the competition in recognition of their time volunteered. Event entrants can be selected to be team officials at the discretion of the AACT committee.
- Two AACT team uniform shirts with be supplied shirts free of charge by AACT Society Inc in the first year of selection and in any subsequent year if required.
- Team officials shall be provided a petty cash advance, of an amount as determined by AACT committee, to cover incidental expenses, which will require acquittal upon completion of the event.
- Team officials must have a current WWVP card and have the number and expiration date lodged with AACT.
- Team officials must complete the media consent form (Appendix 4).

• The Team Manager is the senior member of the AACT team officials and will have the final leadership and decision-making authority.

8.1 Manager Duties:

The Team Manager and Assistant Team Manager shall work together to:

- Attend to the wellbeing and morale of all archers in the team during formal training events and the championships;
- Attend team managers meetings as necessary and keep all team members advised of all relevant information;
- On behalf of the team members and, if required, make representations to the tournament committee and/or jury of appeal;
- Be responsible for the administration and management of the team and the welfare of all team members at training and competition;
- Prepare and submit a report on the performance of the team at a meeting of AACT as soon as practicable after the close of the National Championships; and
- Keep an accurate record of funds and prepare a financial report at the conclusion of the championship for the AACT Committee.

8.2 Team Coach Duties:

The Team Coach shall:

- Organise and run at least one formal training event between team selection and the Championships;
- Provide coaching in both technical and mental aspects, as necessary, during formal training events and the championships;
- Assist archers to repair equipment, as necessary both compound and recurve, during formal training events and the championships;
- Work with the team managers to attend to the wellbeing and morale of all archers in the team during formal training events and the championships;
- Provide individual post-tournament feedback to team members as soon as practicable after the close of the National Championships. Record a copy of the feedback in the AACT Coaches drop box; and
- Keep an accurate record of funds and prepare a financial report at the conclusion of the championship for the AACT Committee.


